

Hexenkessel Blatten - Balalp

To make your visit as enjoyable as possible, we ask you to keep the following in mind.

- You are traveling in a wood several meters above the ground, therefore be responsible, independent and use the safety equipment as demonstrated.
- Every participant must receive instructions and practice those instructions between entering and enjoying the Seilpark.
- Ignoring or violating the instructions provided by the trainers can result in the person being expelled from the Seilpark.

The Seilpark does not accept responsibility for injuries or accidents that may occur.

1. General regulations.

- ✓ Entry fee is valid for up to 3,5 hours
- ✓ The equipment cannot be passed on to another person
- ✓ Long hair must be tied up
- ✓ You cannot wear your backpack in the Seilpark.
- ✓ Seilpark does not accept responsibility for loss of items that fall out of pockets or otherwise are lost.
- ✓ Sunglasses and headwear should only be worn if absolutely necessary. No responsibility will be taken from the loss of such items.
- ✓ Valuables such as mobile phones, keys, backpacks etc... can be stored safely at the ticket office.
- ✓ Only one person is allowed on the course (bridges and Tyroliennes) at any given time. A maximum of three persons is allowed on the platforms at any given time.
- ✓ You are responsible for your own personal safety and the safety of other visitors while in the Seilpark.
- ✓ These regulations are for your own safety. Ignoring or violating them can result in expulsion from the Seilpark
- ✓ If the guest terminates the visit to the adventure park on his or her own initiative no reimbursement of the admission fee takes place
- ✓ We suggest you wear comfortable casual clothes as well as walking or trekking shoes

2. Health concerns

- ✓ Heart problems
- ✓ Alcohol, drugs or medications.
- ✓ Good mental form
- ✓ Fear of heights
- ✓ Pregnancy
- ✓ Obesity

3. Statement

On visiting the Seilpark you will be required to sign a statement.

The statement is your confirmation of understanding that visiting the Seilpark is your responsibility.

4. Children.

An adult must oversee children over 125 cm and up to 14 years of age.

An adult must accompany children over 125 cm and up to 11 years old.

Adult must accompany children between 11 and 14 years of age from the ground throughout the park.

5. Teenagers.

Teenagers from the age of 14 to the age of 18 must have a signed authorization from a parent or custodian.

6. Groups.

Groups that want to visit the Seilpark must book at the Brig-Belalp tourism at least two days in advance. Groups of children must be accompanied and guided with at least 1 adult for 4 children. Groups of teenagers must be accompanied and guided by at least 1 adult for every 6 teenagers.

7. Weather.

In the event of bad weather, management reserves the right to close the Seilpark on grounds of safety for example in the event of fire, storm, rain or bad weather. In that case no reimbursement of entry fees can take place.

8. Trails

Visitors are requested to use walking trails and paths in the area.
